Essex Highways IMPORTANT

There have been instances reported in Central London and Suffolk of 'anti-5G' protesters sticking posters onto street furniture such as telephone infrastructure, electricity cabinets and lamp posts. Some of these posters have blades or other 'sharps' placed behind them, in a deliberate attempt to injure anyone who attempts to remove them.

Please be vigilant - If you find any posters or stickers with 'anti-5G' messages stuck to any street furniture, infrastructure, lamp posts where diffusion tubes are fixed, etc., DO NOT attempt to remove them. If you suspect that the posters harbour blades or other 'sharps' please inform the Police of their location.
