The proposed priorities in the plan are:

- Further investment in crime prevention

- Reducing drug driven violence
- Protect rural and isolated areas
- Improving safety on our roads
- Encouraging volunteers and community support
- Protecting vulnerable people and those affected by crime and abuse
- Reducing violence against women and girls
- Preventing dog theft
- Preventing business crime, fraud and cybercrime
- Supporting our officers and staff
- Increasing collaboration



This is the next stage of our work to develop the Police and Crime, following on from the workshops we held during the summer which some of you participated in as representatives from your parish or town councils.
